


White Bay Power Station was constructed between 1912 and 1917 to power the rail network and is now over 100 years old, having been decomissioned in 1984. The power station is exceptionally significant as the only one retaining machinery and equipment from before the 1950s, demonstrating the process of electricity production and it's use throughout Sydney's

extensive rail network.

White Bay Power Station is wheelchair accessible. There is no parking available at White Bay Power Station. We encourage visitors to catch public transport. The site is on bus route 441/442.
