Rumble grids were being installed on the main access /egress to the site. RCC advised a high-pressure hose for truck wash-down will be installed adjacent to the sediment basin near the exit from the site



A swale was maintained at the top of the embankments to prevent stormwater runoff from overtopping and causing erosion of the embankment.

The pad was progressively being trimmed to final level with DGB providing a limited-dust surface.
