Dear neighbour,

Re: Redevelopment of Harbourside – Darling Drive closure for the Bunn St Bridge removal and partial demolition of the monorail station

As part of the plans to redevelop the Harbourside precinct, upcoming works will require the temporary closure of the northern part of Darling Drive, between the intersection of Darling Drive and Murray Street in the north, and the roundabout near the Sofitel Hotel in the south.

It is anticipated that this section of road will be closed for a period of approximately four days, from **12am 31 March – 5am 3 April 2023**.

Detour routes for vehicle traffic will be put in place and will be clearly signed for those travelling north and south along Darling Drive. Alternate pedestrian and cyclist routes will be provided via the Darling Harbour foreshore and will be clearly signed. Bus routes will be diverted via Murray Street, however please refer to Transport NSW for the latest timetabling and route information.

This road closure will enable the following works:

Monorail Station demolition

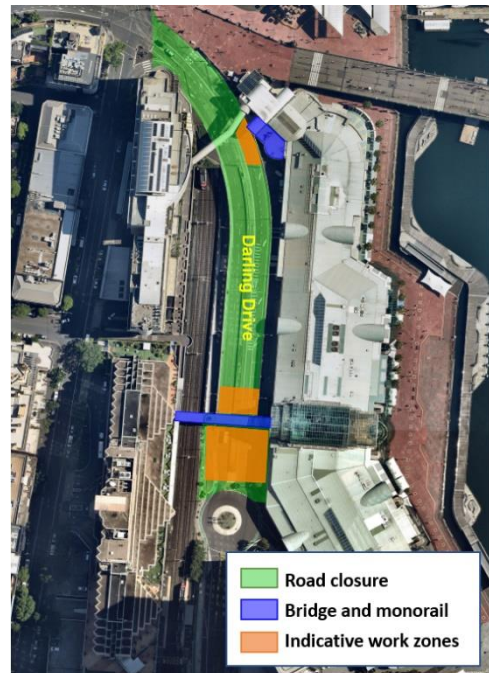
A segment of the redundant Monorail Station which extends over Darling Drive will be demolished. This work will happen during the day.

Pedestrian bridge removal

The pedestrian bridge between the Harbourside Shopping Centre and the Wilson Car Park will be removed. Because this work must be undertaken during the upcoming Light Rail shutdown period, bridge removal may require works throughout the night.

During these works, you may notice a range of vehicles travelling through the area including dump trucks, tipper trucks, work vehicles and rigid trucks to remove recyclable material. The team will also be using the following equipment during this period:

- Mobile cranes and elevated work platforms
- Demolition excavators
- Hammers, breakers, demolition saws and jackhammers.



The health and safety of people in the area is of paramount importance, and all works areas will be secured with barriers and fencing to ensure the safety of those who travel through the area. We will also have strict controls in place to minimise construction impacts associated with demolition works, including noise, dust and vibration.
