Everleigh State School's stage 2 has been completed. Students are using the extra learning spaces and the state-of-the-art sports hall, soundproof music room and fantastic play areas. The investment in this school will continue to support families calling Everleigh and Greenbank home.

Park Ridge State High School has had a new two story Design and Technology Hub completed. The new building will provide learning opportunities in robotics and virtual reality as well as allowing students of hospitality and tourism to have up to date learning spaces. They also have relocated and updated the wellness center for the school based GP, guidance officers and school chaplains to continue to support the students.

It's always a great time at the Everleigh Estate, especially this time of year.

The major highlight and privilege for me as your local Councillor was to attend the sod turning event with the Mayor to celebrate the AFL clubhouse and cafe that will be built on the AFL grounds right here in Everleigh. After several years of hard fought planning, I was ecstatic to see plans coming to fruition with construction due to start in March 2024. This building will be a feature point for the freshly finished AFL grounds itself.

The Everleigh team is proud to have delivered over over 850 residential lots and 8.5ha public open space.

Mirvac Development Update

And just like that, Chapter 2023 comes to a close – and what a chapter it was.

With the Tuscan Release opening in January, Ochre in May, Marigold in July and Evergreen in September, the Everleigh project team has delivered some 230 home sites over the course of the year; and with the finishing touches being applied to the Vista release, we're set to start 2024 on the front foot.

Away from earth-moving and into grass-manicuring, one of our many highlights of the year was the completion of the Everleigh AFL Oval. We are so proud to have brought on the flood-lights, kicked our first goals (from outside-50) and welcomed the Community and the Greenbank Giants (formerly the Park Ridge Pirates) to this state-of-the-art facility. With over 2,500 people attending the Everleigh Football Festival (Grand Opening of the AFL Ovals), we marked the largest event in Mirvac Queensland history. One of many Premierships we could not have achieved without your support. To begin the end of year festivities, we celebrated with over 2,000 people at the Everleigh Christmas Fireworks at the start of December. We welcome the coming break as a great opportunity to reflect and reset for 2024 – because we have plenty more to come.

We would like to take an opportunity to thank all of our project teams for your unwavering effort this year and every other year, as well as you – our community – for your ongoing support to all things Everleigh.
